**Dominating the enchanting city of Malaga, Gibralfaro Hill offers a journey through time from its Roman Amphitheatre, to the Moorish Alcazaba, to the Phoenician Castillo.**

Lovers of modern art should

head to the Picasso Museum. Towering above Gibraltar is the Northern Pillar of Hercules. See the Great Siege Tunnels and recently-opened Second World War tunnels; the natural spectacle of St. Michael's Cave;

and the legendary Barbary Apes. From Arrecife explore the Montaña del Fuego where the Islote de Hilario smoulders with a scarlet glow; as well as the Mirador del Rio and 16th century Castillo de San José.

the elegant Sunbury Plantation House; or join the jet set relaxing on a pristine beach. On the spice island of Grenada, enjoy a drive into the interior to see the Grand Etang Forest Reserve, or explore the Georgian buildings of the horseshoe Carnegie inner harbour. The dreamy atmosphere continues in the St. Lucian capital Castries, whose Columbus Square is lined with shops and houses painted in shades of amber, saffron, pink and blue.

Centrepiece of quintessential St. Kitts is the Circus; but don't miss Brimstone Hill Fortress National Park. Drake's Passage is navigated before arriving at Road Town, capital of delightful Tortola, where you can visit Old Government House; or head to the Mount Healthy Windmill National Park. In colonial Nassau enjoy some retail therapy in Bay Street.



In Tenerife take a tour to Las Cañadas National Park; or the Orotava Valley, with its famous Drago trees, Iglesia de la Concepción, and Casa de las Balcones. The peaceful harbour at Mindelo in the Cape Verde Islands is as atmospheric as it is tranquil, with cobblestone streets and pastel-coloured colonial buildings.

After five days at sea get your first taste of the Caribbean in bustling Bridgetown; travel back in time at
